On February 3, 2025, Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC filed an application in the above-captioned docket to amend its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the Southgate Project ("Amendment Project"). On August 15, 2025, Mountain Valley submitted the Biological Assessment for the Amendment Project.

In response to Environmental Information Request No. 4, Mountain Valley made minor updates to the Biological Assessment and is submitting herewith a redline version showing the changes made as well as a clean version. The updated version of the Biological Assessment contains material that is privileged and confidential consistent with Section 388.112 of the Commission's regulations, 18 C.F.R. § 388.112, because the Biological Assessment identifies, among other things, suitable habitat and individual species occurrence data.
